He was an avid pheasant and deer hunter. He enjoyed fishing with his family and also horseback riding with his wife, Doris.

During his time in Bella Vista and Mesa he enjoyed golfing. He started the Bocce Ball group in Sunland Springs Village, and also loved playing shuffle board. Byrdell enjoyed socializing and playing cards with friends and neighbors.

Byrdell is preceded in death by his parents, Burr and Mae Clark and his brothers, Kenneth, Otis, Milo,

and Lowell Clark. He is survived by his brother, Dale Clark. Also survived by his daughter, Mary Ann Henry, and his sons, Thomas Miles, John Reed, and Timothy David Clark as well grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
