

James Robert Glasgow, 77, of Bella Vista, Arkansas died Sunday, December 18, 2016 at Mercy Hospital in Rogers, Arkansas. He was born November 1, 1939 in Eureka Springs, Arkansas to Angus Benton Glasgow and Edith Gay (Palmer) Glasgow.
